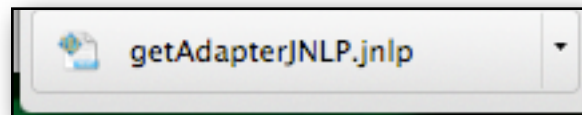
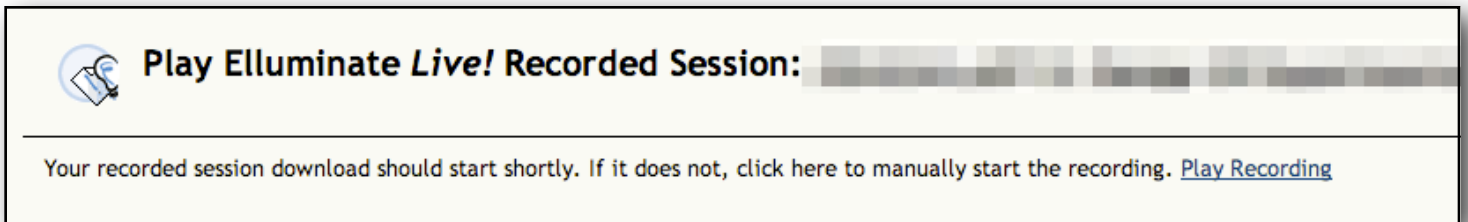
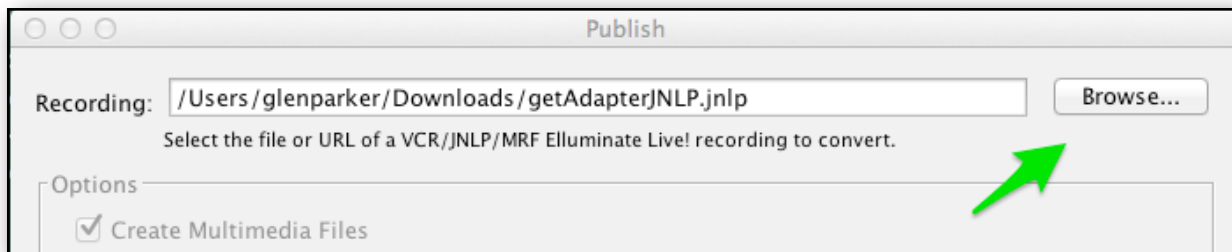


How to make standalone videos from Elluminate recordings

- 1) Go to http://www.illuminate.com/Other/eLearning_Publish!/?id=357 , download, and install Elluminate Publish for your operating system
- 2) Go into Blackboard, into the course with your recordings. Click to play that recording. This will download the .JNLP file for that recording. (If the recording automatically starts playing, stop it).



- 3) Open Elluminate Publish, browse for the .JNLP file downloaded in step (2).



The .vcr file will be downloaded automatically.

4) Choose the conversion options. We recommend the following Options. Click Convert, then choose where to save the converted video files.

Illuminate will open and begin playing the recording. The conversion takes approx. 4.0x as long as the recording. Do not close it or the conversion will fail. The process runs unattended, you can leave it and do something else.
